## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Supporting All Pro-5 ducers Act" or the "SAP Act".

## 6 SEC. 2. ACER ACCESS AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

7 Section 12306 of the Agricultural Act of 2014 (7

6	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Beginning with the first re-
7	quest for applications under this section that occurs
8	at least 1 year after the date of the enactment of
9	the SAP Act, not later than 6 months before such
10	a request for applications, the Secretary shall solicit
11	input from maple industry stakeholders with respect
12	to the research and education priorities of the maple
13	industry.
